

AIRPLANE NOISE ADVISORY COMMITTEE

CHARGE

The Airplane Noise Advisory Committee (“ANAC” or the “Committee”) shall be appointed by the Select Board and shall consist of at least three (3) and no more than five (5) members. Each member will be appointed to a one-year term, which may be renewed at the discretion of the Select Board. The Committee shall advise the Select Board on issues relating to air traffic over the Town of Milton and work to reduce the impacts of airplane noise and pollution on residents’ health and quality of life.

To achieve these goals, ANAC shall:

- Work in collaboration with the Select Board, the Town’s representative to the Massport Community Advisory Committee (or its successor), the Board of Health, and the Town’s Environmental Coordinator to seek solutions that will minimize or alleviate the hazards of noise, air pollution, and the low elevation of aircraft flying over the Town;
- Assist the Select Board with its efforts to achieve dispersion of aircraft arriving to Runways 4R and 4L and departing from Runway 27 at Logan International Airport;
- Work with the Environmental Coordinator to ensure that aircraft noise and pollution impacts in Milton is measured and data is collected, including through the use of noise and/or air quality monitors placed on public or private property;
- Educate residents about the potential health risks of airplane noise and pollution in general; and
- Report its progress to the Select Board as needed and at least annually.
