

Use of fire pits

- Use of fire pits shall be allowed provided the following rules set forth in 527 CMR 1.00 Massachusetts Comprehensive Fire Safety Code are complied with
- CMR 527 defines a recreational fire as a fire not more than 3' in diameter, and not more than 2' above the ground
- Recreational fires shall not be located within 25' of a structure or combustible material unless contained in an approved manner.
- Conditions that could cause a fire to spread to within 25' of a structure shall be eliminated prior to ignition.
- Open recreational, and cooking fires shall be constantly attended by a competent person until such fire is extinguished.
- This person shall have a garden hose connected to the water supply or other fire extinguishing equipment readily available for use.
