Enterprise Funds

Town operates three enterprise funds: Water, Sewer, and Stormwater

These funds are fully-funded by user fees billed based on usage (water and sewer) or impervious area (stormwater).

Each Enterprise Fund also maintains “retained earnings” (Free Cash).

Enterprise Fund	Retained Earnings
Water	\$2,946,824
Sewer	\$512,570
Stormwater	\$78,431
