

Household Hazardous Waste Collection

Where can I drop off my hazardous waste?

Milton DPW Yard, 629 Randolph Ave., Milton. Rain or shine. Free to Milton residents. **Residents will be asked to show ID for proof of residency.** Acceptable forms of ID include a driver's license or utility bill for a Milton address. Materials should be left in their original containers whenever possible. Containers should be placed in sturdy boxes and placed in the trunk of a vehicle so that contents will be easy to remove. **Residents will remain in their vehicles during the entire collection.**

What can I bring?

- ✓ Adhesives and glues
- ✓ Aerosol cans
- ✓ Engine degreaser, brake and transmission fluid, and other automotive fluids (unmixed)
- ✓ Flammable liquids and aerosols
- ✓ Household cleaners and spot removers
- ✓ Oil-based paints
- ✓ Photo chemicals and chemistry sets
- ✓ Poisons, insecticides, pesticides, weed killers
- ✓ Solvents and varnishes
- ✓ Swimming pool chemicals
- ✓ Acids, bases, drain cleaners
- ✓ Waste fuels (kerosene, gasoline)
- ✓ Wood preservatives and fiberglass residue

What items are NOT accepted?	How can I dispose of these?
X Latex – based paints	Let dry (use kitty litter to speed process) and dispose as trash.
X Fuses or fuse guns	Return to store or manufacturer.
X Firearms, shell, and related equipment	Return to store, manufacturer, Milton Police Department, or shooting range.
X Flares	Return to store or manufacturer.
X Textiles and clothing	Drop off in marked donation boxes in Milton public school parking lots.
X Needles and syringes	Dispose at Milton Health Department 617-898-4886.
X Medication	Dispose at Milton Police Department or a pharmacy.
X Mattresses	Fill out the Mattress Collection Form or call DPW to request a Tuesday pick up.
X Asbestos	Hire a licensed asbestos removal company.
