Thank you for submitting your application for the Municipal ADA Improvement Grant Program for FY25.

We received your grant application to participate in the Municipal ADA Improvement Grant program. Grant awards under this program are contingent upon the municipality being able to certify that it will comply with all applicable laws, including the Massachusetts General Laws. We understand that the Executive Office of Housing and Livable Communities has determined the Town of Milton out of compliance with G.L. c. 40A, § 3A, the MBTA Communities Act. To be eligible to participate in the ADA grant program, the Town of Milton would need to remediate this noncompliance.

At this time, we are therefore unable to approve your grant request, but the Town of Milton may be eligible to apply for funds from this program in the future if compliance is certified.

We hope to continue to receive funding for the FY26 round of the Municipal with ADA Improvement Grant Program.
