To Whom It May Concern:

This is to certify that the following is a true copy of Article 7 of the Warrant for the Special Town Meeting held February 25, 2025, and of the vote passed thereunder.

ARTICLE 7 To see if the Town will vote to appropriate, borrow or transfer from available funds, an amount of money to be expended under the direction of the School Building Committee for a feasibility study of an elementary or middle school project for the Cunningham School, 44 Edge Hill Road, Milton, MA 02186, for which feasibility study the Town may be eligible for a grant from the Massachusetts School Building Authority. The MSBA's grant program is a non-entitlement, discretionary program based on need, as determined by the MSBA, and any costs the Town incurs in connection with the feasibility study in excess of any grant approved by and received from the MSBA shall be the sole responsibility of the Town.

VOTED. The Town of Milton appropriated the amount of one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) for the purpose of paying costs of a feasibility study of an elementary or middle school project for the Cunningham School, 44 Edge Hill Road, Milton, MA 02186, including the payment of all costs incidental or related thereto, and for which the Town may be eligible for a grant from the Massachusetts School Building Authority ("MSBA"), said amount to be expended under the direction of the School Building Committee, provided that no funds be expended until the Town and MSBA execute the Feasibility Study Agreement. To meet this appropriation the Treasurer, with the approval of the Select Board, is authorized to borrow said amount under and pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 44, or pursuant to any other enabling authority. The Town acknowledges that the MSBA's grant program is a non-entitlement, discretionary program based on need, as determined by the MSBA, and any costs the Town incurs in excess of any grant approved by and received from the MSBA shall be the sole responsibility of the Town, and that the amount of borrowing authorized pursuant to this vote shall be reduced by any grant amount set forth in the Feasibility Study Agreement that may be executed between the Town and the MSBA.
